

The Black Forgiveness Expectation: Predictors of Positive Perceptions of Black Forgiveness

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INTRODUCTION

- o Societal expectations of black forgiveness for racial transgressions (Johnson & Fisher, 2019).
- o Quickness to forgive can overshadow pain (Wedderburn & Carey, 2017).
- o Predictors of positive perceptions of forgiveness.

METHODS

- o Multiple Regression Design
- o N = 281 (119 male and 162 female) undergraduate participants (54.1% White, 23.5% Hispanic, 3.2% Black, 4.3% Bi/Multiracial, 1.4 % Arab, 0.7% Native American, 0.4% Other)
- o Predictors: Patriotism and Nationalism ($\alpha = .94$), Racial Privilege ($\alpha = .91$), Institutional Discrimination ($\alpha = .82$), Blatant Racial Issues (Neville et al., 2000; $\alpha = .82$), History Knowledge ($\alpha = .79$), Religiosity (Worthington et al., 2012; $\alpha = .96$), Political Outlook
- o Outcomes: Perceptions of Black (Leach et al., 2011; $\alpha = .64$) and White forgiveness ($\alpha = .60$), and tendency to forgive (Brown, 2003; $\alpha = .63$)

RESULTS & DISCUSSION

- o Patriotism, nationalism, and colorblindness positively predicted endorsement of forgiveness.
- o Correlational design
- o Colorblindness may lead individuals to endorse Black forgiveness, potentially reinforcing racial oppression.

Patriotism, nationalism, and colorblindness predicted endorsement of forgiveness.
