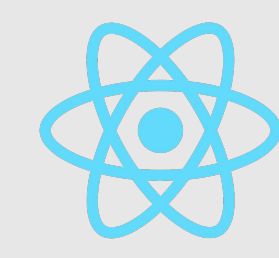




Introduction & Background

Methodology



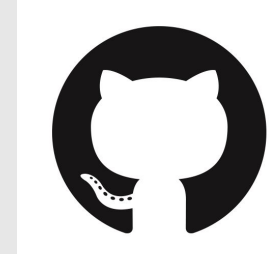
React will be used to design the user interface for our system

GoDaddy will be used to host our web domain "mapp.city"



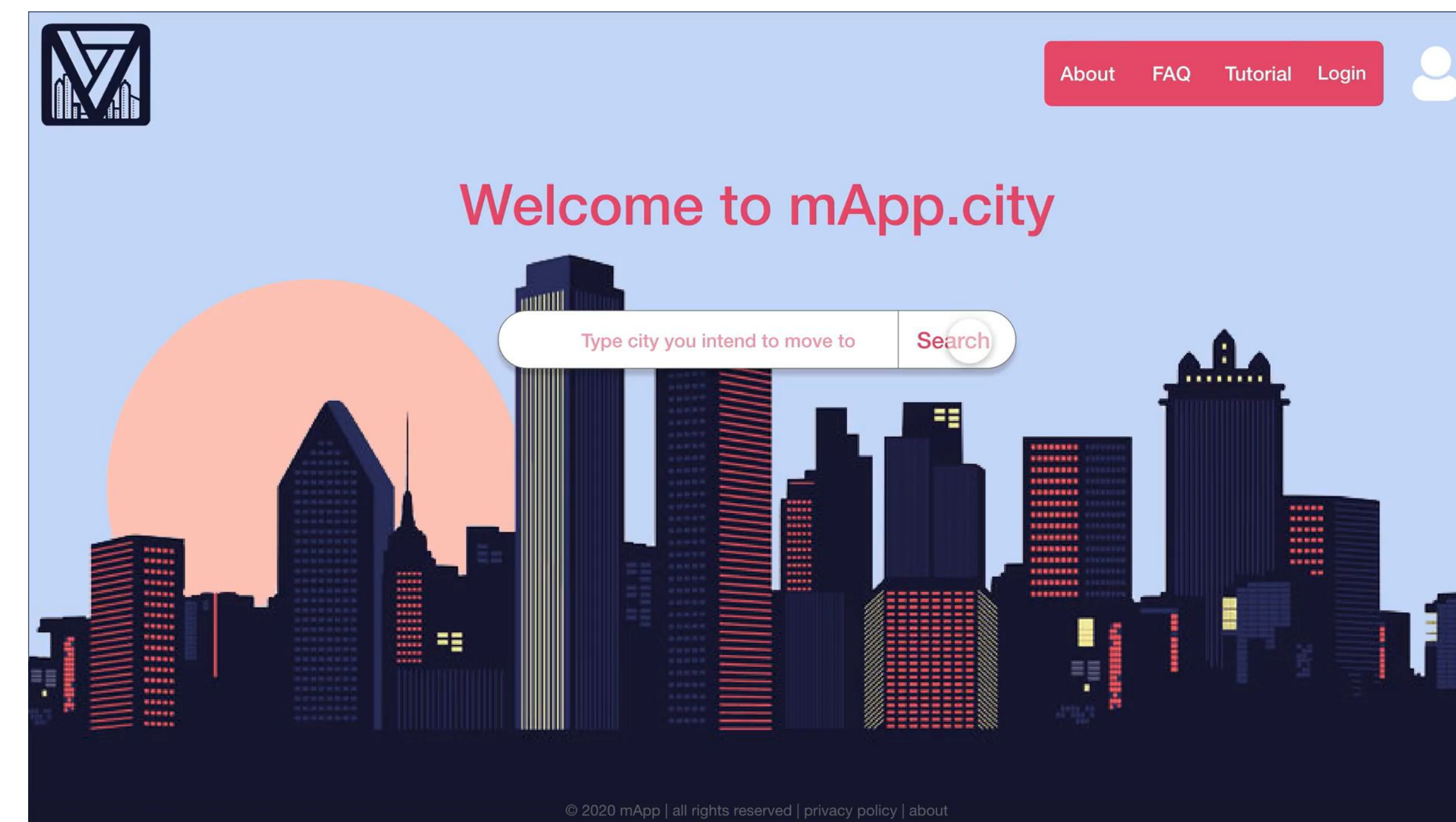
GitHub will be used to share code among the team while developing the website

Evaluation & Definition of Success

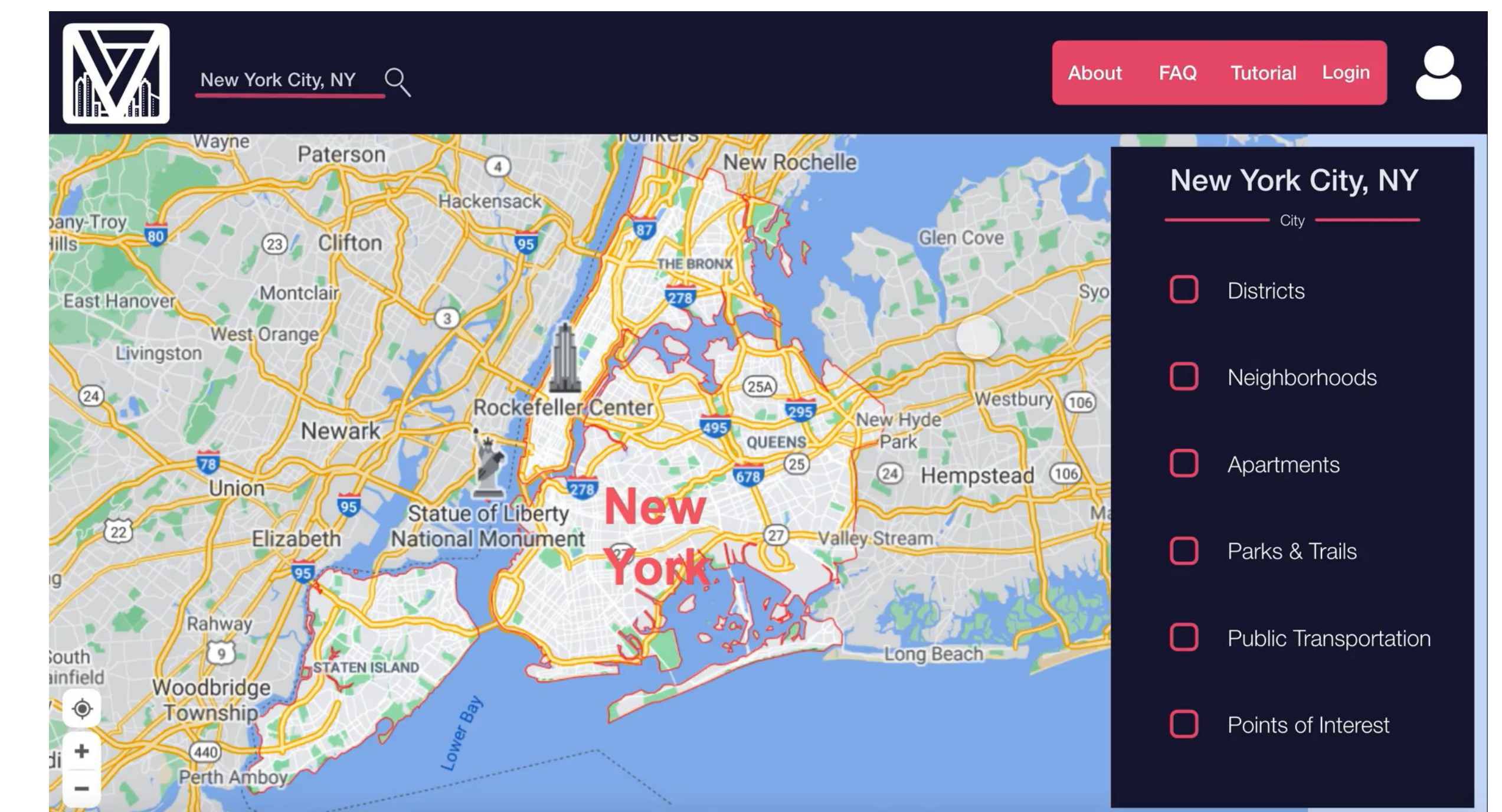
- Conduct a user study for our website

Related and Prior Works

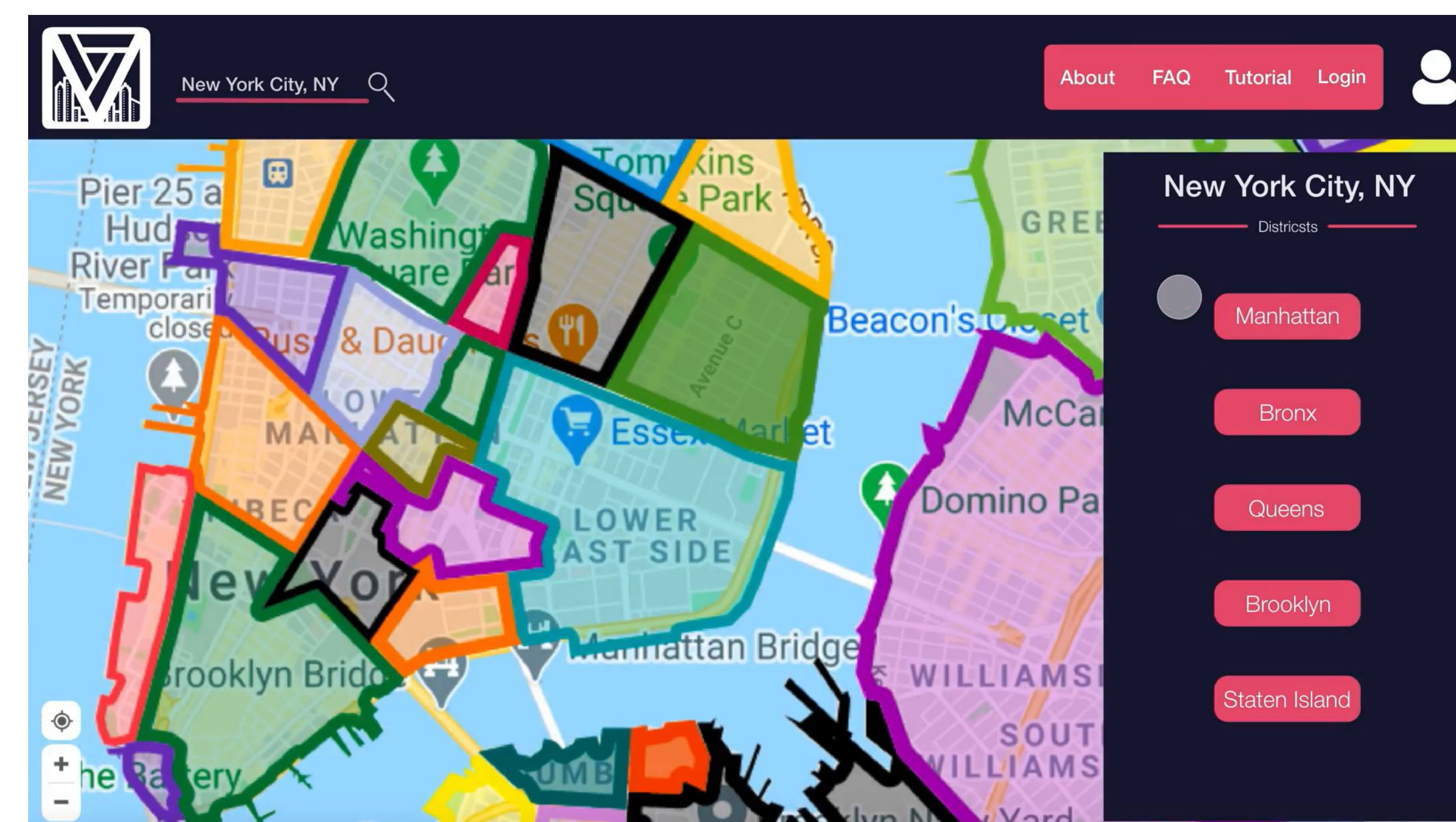
- walkscore.com

 - Info not always useful (e.g. number of bridges in the city)
 - Messy user interface

 - Geared more specifically for real-estate purposes
- musicmap.info
 - Presents the user with a clean and elegant user interface that dynamically changes when scrolling
 - This is based on music and is serving as more of an inspiration for our visual style



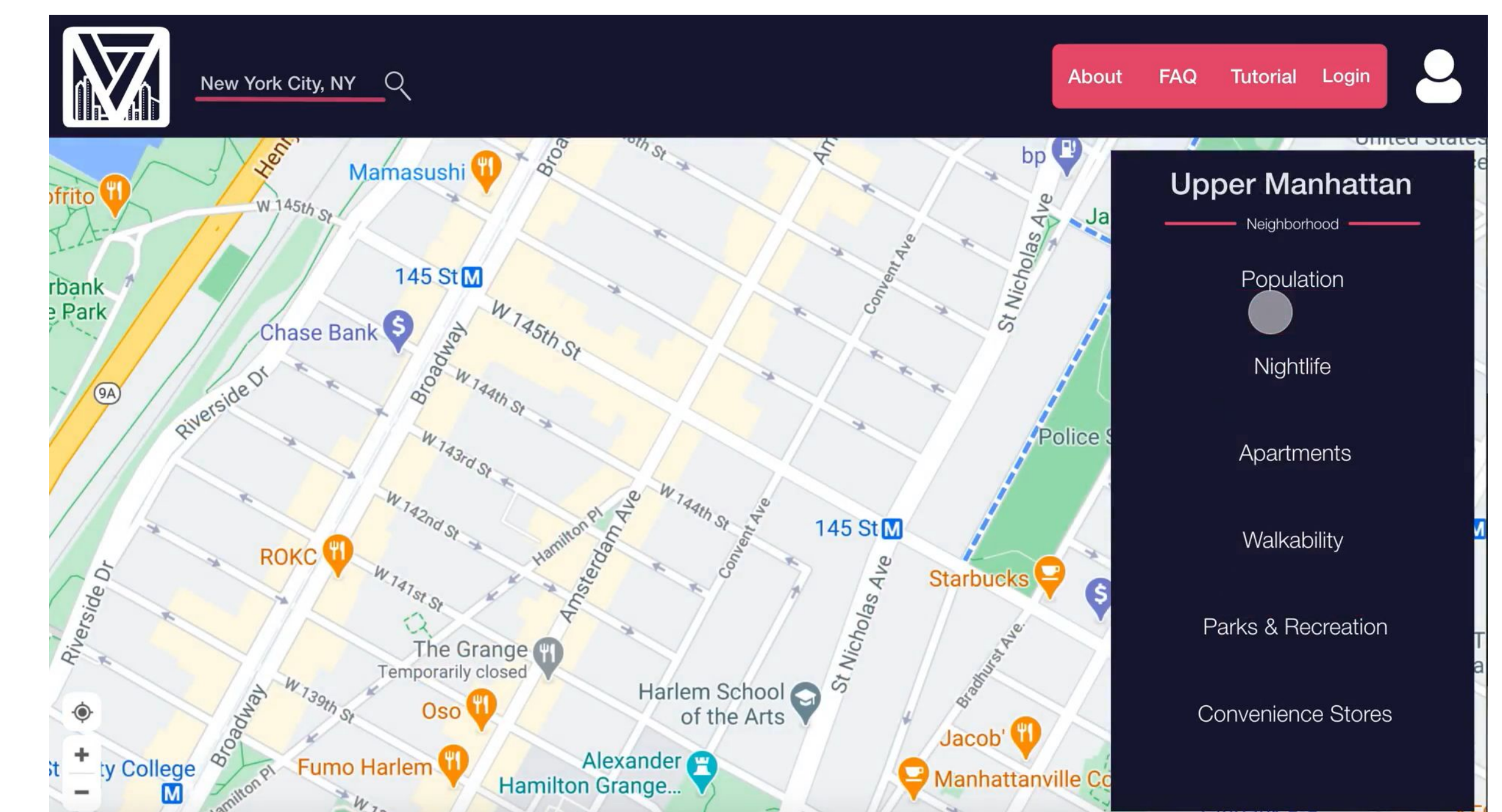
Landing Page
